Far from being a divisive force, Roberts argues, conversion to Christianity serves to integrate the slum community—Christians and Hindus alike—by addressing hidden moral fault lines in the slum that subtly pit women against one another. Christians and Hindus in the slum are not opposed; they are united in a struggle to survive in a national context that renders Dalits outsiders in their own homes.
